Hi. I haven't checked out this thread in years, but I now have a lot of information on both Broussard lines in Louisiana. There are two lines, one French Creole, and one Acadian. I am descended from the French Creole line, and here is what I have on them. I realize that my work is not in correct genealogical format. It's not strictly a genealogy. It's an attempt at a family history, and my intention is to add a lot more pictures and document copies. I'm including only as far back as can be confirmed.

GENERATION 34 – ISAAC URBAIN BROSSARD

ISAAC URBAIN BROSSARD, son of MATHURIN BROSSARD and MICHELLE BIDAULT/BIDAUD/BIDEAU/BIDEAT, born January 4, 1633 in the parish of St-Germain-du-Val, La Fleche, Anjou, diocese of Angiers, France; died April 10, 1710 Montreal, Quebec, Canada, buried April 17, 1710 Montreal, Quebec, Canada (Official witnesses to the burial: Cesneau and Mr Henri Meriel, priest of the seminar; Yves Priate, vicar of the parish, performed the burial service)

From the internet:

“In 1653, Isaac-Urbain Brossard was part of the "Great Recrue" Montreal, ie, this group of almost a hundred [102] young men who agreed to immigrate to Ville-Marie (Montreal), New

France, by committing to 5 years to Paul Chomedey de Maisonneuve, governor of Montreal. Just before his departure for New France, Urbain received 104 livres and 18 floors advances on his wages, which he acknowledged by a notarial act before the notary Belliotte. On 16 November 1653, Urbain arrived at Montreal with his companions of the "Great Recrue" and settled thereafter."

Married URBAIN ODIAU/HODIAU/AUDIAU/ODIO DIONET DIT LA FLECHE, daughter of SEBASTIEN HODIAU DIONET DIT LA FOSSE (LAFLECHE) and MARIE MOUSNIER/MEUNIER/LEMONIER, born 1645 or 1646 in Faubourg St. Germain, La Fleche, Anjou, France; died July 15, 1681 Montreal, Quebec, Canada

Urbaine Odiau traveled with her mother, Marie Mousnier Odiau, in 1659 on one of a fleet of three ships of the "Great Rookie", the "Prince Guillaume", to meet her father, Sebastien Odiau, who was already in Quebec.

Note that the ship, "St. Andrew", was leased to a JEAN JACQUES MOUSNIER (same last name as the mother of URBAIN HODIAU).

From the internet (translated from the French):

The 1659 "Rookie of Montreal" expedition of three ships from France crossing to New France was very dramatic. Even before the departure from La Flèche, inhabitants of La Fleche, on learning that the nuns and girls are going to sail to La Rochelle, then from there to the New World, are skeptical at the thought that "these frail ladies" will do so voluntarily, believing instead that "they will be loaded by force". On 26 May at the sight of horses the locals blocked the road and Mr. Robutel of St. Andrew and other gentlemen forming the escort forced their way through the crowd, threatening them with their swords. Robutel had with him his new wife, Suzanne Gabriel.

At least one of the vessels, the "St. Andrew", was leased to Jean Jacques MOUSNIER for 1400 L a month by the weapon. At La Rochelle the ship-owner Jean NEZEREAU did not want to sail. No doubt influenced by events, he demanded that the passages were to be paid in advance and it appears he took the opportunity to raise prices at the last moment. According to Marguerite BOURGEOYS he asked then 175 L in lieu of 50 Passengers agreed to this amount, which included provisions and chests. Jeanne MANCE, following a contract with the settlers, obtained a loan for the money. The sum required for their passage and their food by MANCE seems to have been 75 L for adults and young people, L for 50 adolescents, 25 L for toddlers. On 5 June the families had severally obligated to repay within two years these advances. It was not repaid immediately, as Jeanne MANCE did not deliver a final bill before the notary in Basset until 1669, ten years later.

In July the ship St. Andrew was ready to go but it had served for two years as a Navy hospital ship and it had not been quarantined, and became infected with the plague. Just offshore contagion wins all passengers. Eight to ten people; died at sea and perhaps eighteen in all with those who; died on arrival at Quebec, according to the abbot, Faillon, who made the statement. The ship arrived at Quebec on 7 September, 1659 at 7 pm. The hospital in Quebec is filled with

the sick at the worst point and the others are housed in a Montreal warehouse, where the goods were placed in waiting to go on small vessels to Montreal. This was not the only test they had to endure since the ship "suffered the most furious storm and was in obvious danger of dying."

Relations reported the arrival on the vessel of two priests: Lemaître and Jacques Guillaume VIGNAL, Supplicants. On the role is mentioned that the two priests are:

"Mr. Labbé for the Queylus.

NOTE: Before 1660, the first girls who came to Canada looking for husbands were known as "Filles à Marier", or "marriageable daughters". They were few in number and often paid their own way through contracts and indentures. After 1663, the French royal authorities became concerned with propagation of people in their Canadian colony. Therefore, the King himself directed the first recruitment of young women of good quality for the purpose of marrying the single men already in Quebec. These were known as "filles du roi", or "king's daughters".

“The Grande Recrue of 1653”

Ville-Marie was founded in 1642, by the members of the Société Notre-Dame de Montréal. After ten years of effort, the existence of the colony is in danger and reinforcements are necessary in order to ensure its survival. Jeanne Mance persuades Paul de Chomedey de Maisonneuve, founder of Montreal, to go to France and recruit colonists to breathe new life into the colony. With the support of Jerome Royer, of Dauversière, a recruitment campaign takes place in Maine and Anjou, in particular in the area of La Flèche, in order to engage a minimum of 100 men. The objective was achieved.

M. de Maisonneuve also met with Marguerite Bourgeoise, a woman who had tried to enter religious life, but was refused, and had joined the ranks of the Congregation of Notre-Dame de Troyes as an extern member, and taught poor children for several years in the city of Troyes, becoming the leader of the group of about 400 laywomen, who, like her, had devoted themselves to the service of the poor and destitute. M. de Maisonneuve, the Governor of Montreal, convinced Marguerite to return with him to Canada as a lay teacher for the children of the colonists and natives of Ville-Marie. “Sister” Marguerite” accepted the offer, and was to bring a handful of girls with her.

Between May and March 1653, 117 men sign contracts of service for a period from three to five years towards the Compagnie de Montréal. On July 20, 1653, 102 of these men, accompanied by M. de Maisonneuve, embark from Saint-Nazaire, on the Saint-Nicolas de Nantes. Marguerite Bourgeoys and 14 young women also form part of the travellers. This group of immigrants will, from now on, be known under the name of the Grande Recrue de 1653 (Great Recruit of 1653) by the Quebec genealogists. After a painful crossing, the ship lands in Quebec on September 22, 1653. On November 16, 1653, the Grande Recrue arrives at Ville-Marie.

Paul Benoit, son of François Benoit and Marie-Dimanche Chaplain, was intelligent, but not formally educated. He was a carpenter looking for a new life. In 1653, when he was approximately 25 years old, he was recruited by M.de Maisonneuve, probably in Nevers, France to be sent to New France. M. de Maisonneuve had been trying since the autumn of 1651 to engage 200 colonist-soldiers to save and develop a city in Quebec in New France, then called Ville-Marie [Ville Marie, now Montreal], which was proving to be a difficult task. M. de Maisonneuve succeeded in obtaining the signatures of 154 men. Of this number, 102 honoured their commitment, one of these being Paul Benoît, who signed his engagement for 5 years in front of the Lafousse notary, in Laflèche, on March 23, 1653. Because he excelled at his work, he was promised an annual salary of 100 pounds. On June 20, 1653, at the port of St-Nazaire, before the notary Belliote, he was given advanced wages of 123 pounds. On that same day, June 20, 1653, this group of 120 recruits boarded the ship St-Nicholas of Nantes at the port city of St-Nazaire, located at the mouth of the Loire, The sailors hoisted the sails of St-Nicolas. The ship then pointed its hesitant prow towards News-France.

Difficult crossing

It wasn't long before the recruits realized that the ship on which they were traveling was worm-eaten, was rotted, and that it was taking on water. All the men, including Paul Benoit, were mobilized to seal the ship. Their efforts were useless. After having travelled 350 lieus at sea, it was necessary to turn back. Water invaded the hold and threatened to spoil the provisions. Sister Marguerite Bourgeois wrote that all would have perished without the help of people of the coast. M.de Maisonneuve put off all of the recruits onto an island before returning to St-Nazaire, fearing that if they returned with him, they would all flee. The experts examined the ship, declaring it a death trap. It was necessary to return to shore to find another ship. All provisions that had been used or destroyed by water would need to be replaced.. The men who were waiting on the island had to be taken care of at the expense of the company of Montreal. Finally, July 20, 1653, a month after the original departure, they set sail towards the New-World.

Unfortunately for all, their bad luck continued. Disease struck the passengers aboard the vessel and, according to Sister Bourgeois' writings, eight of the passengers died at sea. We do not know how many suffered from the sickness, or if Paul Benoit contracted the disease. We do know that among his companions in misfortune were Isaac-Urbain de Brossard, Jean Auger, Etienne Bouchard, Honore Danis, Hugues Picard, Pierre Desautels, Pierre Godin. Louis Guertin, Gilles Lauzon, Jean Valiquet, along with about 90 others. In addition, 14 girls accompanied Sister Marguerite Bourgeois.

Finally, the recruits reached the shores of Quebec on Monday September 22, 1653. The ship was in such bad shape that it was on the point of sinking and had to be burned on the spot.

Paul Benoit and his friends were in a hurry to reach Ville-Marie. The governor of Montreal since the previous April, a Mr. de Lauzon, refused to provide boats to Mr. de Maisonneuve to take the passengers ashore. It was nearly two months after reaching the shores of New France, that on November 16, 1653, Paul Benoît and the other members of the recruit set foot on the shores of Ville-Marie, to the inexpressible joy of all the Montréalaise population.

Weddings at Ville-Marie

Paul Benoît excelled as a carpenter, and did well in Ville-Marie. From historical records, it is known that since 1655, he had a dwelling along the street St-Paul, between neighbors Etienne Bouchard and André Dumets. In the summer of 1658 Paul was approximately 32 years old. For some time he had wanted a home and family. He met a young lady who had recently arrived from France. Elisabeth Gobinet was the daughter of Nicolas Gobinet and Marguerite Largeleux de Gonesse in Vexin, district of Montmorency, archbishop's palace of Paris. She was approximately 17 years old at the time of their engagement.

On September 9, 1658, Elisabeth and Paul signed their marriage contract before the Notary Public. Present at this civil ceremony were Louis D' Ailleboust, Governor of New-France and Barbe of Boulogne, his wife; Paul de Chomedey, Governor of Montreal; Jeanne Mance; Lambert Closed; Gilbert Barbier; Jean QAubuchon; Louis Chartier; Pierre Desautels; URBAIN BROUSSARD; and others.

Following tradition, the bridal blessing took place on a Monday. On September 16, six couples were presented in front of the same priest, who forgot to sign the marriage documents. That priest was probably Gabriel Souart, Sulpicien, first priest of Ville-Marie a nephew of the récollet Joseph LeCaron. To testify to their presence at the marriage of Paul and Elisabeth, Paul de Chomedey de Maisonneuve, Governor of Montreal, and Bénigne Bassethound, known as Deslauriers, signed their names as witnesses.

Landowner

On May 12, 1659, Paul Benoit obtained 2 arpents of ground facing the river with a 15 arpents depth, the whole located between the ground of Pierre Picoté de Belestre and that of Marie Fournin, widow of Testard de Laforest, And next on June 30, Jacques Milot exchanged his property of 30 arpents square since August 30, 1655, had, for the site of a half arpent of ground to the hands of Paul Benoit in the center of the village of Ville-Marie. Paul gives at the same time the house of frame which it had built there. Before returning it, it will have it "to cover boards with its expenses", to raise a chimney, to build a baker's oven of two minots with a well built masonry, the whole finished before September 29, 1659.

Meanwhile on July 6, Urbain Jetté commits himself building in mud-walling a house belonging to Benoît. This one promised to him to pay 53 pounds like market price. Then Paul sought to resell the ground which he had acquired of Jacques Milot. A purchaser introduced on August 11 of the same summer, Bertrand of Rennes, known as Pachanne. This one was ready to spend 900 pounds for this property, provided that Benoît finishes the solage frame of already raised house, makes a baking oven for bread, etc

Paul Benoît owned several properties. A contract signed by Basset hound on January 7, 1660, teaches us that he had received another ground concession in the field of the lords on May 12, 1659, which he sold to Robert Jurie. This was a long-term agreement by which Paul Benoit was to be paid 17 minots grain per year. It is known that Robert Jurie contracted with Adam Dollard, siur d'Ormeaux, to fight Length-Salt, and that he "ran away by himself and was turned over to the French by Dutchmen". The contract with Robert Jurie forfeited, Paul Benoit sold this ground, consisting of 3 arpents, to Honore Langlois, dit Lachapelle, on October 18, 1660, for a

compensation for 208 pounds tournaments. The purchaser, Honore Langlois, agreed to give Paul Benoit 10 lime barrels which were valued at 5 books the barrel. . Up until this time, Paul Benoit lived mainly by his trade of carpenter and mason. With hard work and diligence, he was doing very well.

Militiaman

Mr. de Maisonneuve founded the first organized regular militia in 1663, the militia of the Co.-Family of Jesus, Marie and Joseph. Today, we have a defense system able to intervene with the slightest warning, day and night. For the time of Paul Benoit also, it was necessary to be always on guard. The Iroquois were a constant threat to the village of Montreal. On January 27, 1663, Paul de Chomedey, governor of Montreal, signed a proclamation calling upon volunteers of the island to ensure its defense. The following day, he spoke to the public, asking for volunteers for the militia. Twenty groups were set up, seven men in each group. Paul Benoit belonged to the sixth group. Others in the group with Paul Benoit were Etienne Trudeau, Jean Desroches, Nicolas Godé, Pierre Papin and François Bailly, under the direction of Corporal Gilbert Barber. After the passage of the regiment of Carignan, the regular militia was paid by the government of Montreal. There were however voluntary contributions. Thus the role of the inhabitants of the island in the year 1673 presents like one of the cotiseurs Paul Benoit. It had provided 10 grounds.

Opposite the Co.-Helene island.

The census taker of 1667 shows the neighbors of Paul Benoit to be Pierre Picoté, sior of Belestre, and the widow Marie Pournin, the same owners mentioned at the time of the purchase of his batch on May 12, 1659. The location of where these people lived in Ville-Marie, is close to the street Iberville today, opposite the Co.-Helene island. Paul then had 12 arpents of cultivated ground and an animal with horns.

In August 1667, Paul Benoit, Honore Danis dit Tourangeau and Nicolas Wire, agreed to build “a roof of frame with two attic windows” for the account of Jean-Baptiste Migeon, sior of Bransat. Total and authenticated promised price: 61 pounds.

Pierre Picoté was interested in purchasing a ground of 10 poles broad by 5 pole length in front of the ground of his Benoit neighbor. The purchase agreement was signed on April 27, 1670 for the price and summons of 55 pounds.

Obviously, building beautiful houses interested Paul Benoit more than cultivating the land. He was an excellent carpenter. The baillif of the island of Montreal resorted even to his services. Paul and Gilbert Barbier signed an agreement on September 6, 1673, to construct a house for Pierre Gadois for the sum of 250 pounds.

Pioneer of Longeuil.

Paul Benoit, around 1674, crossed the river to settle on the south bank, more precisely in Longeuil, where he had been invited by the new lord of the place. Charles Lemoyne, who had been enobled since March 1668, and obtained from Jean Talon, on November 13, 1672, a seigniory. Lemoyne named the area Longeuil in memory of a village in Normandy, located today in the district of Dieppe, France. On June 14, 1674, the baptismal certificate of Jacques Benoit is signed by Paul Benoit, “inhabitant of Longeuil”. Paul accepted his titles of concession of 3 arpents by 20, on March 20, 1675. His concessionary neighbors were François Bleau and Guillaume Gendron dit de Rolandière. The census of 1681 states that Paul had five animals with horns and twelve arpents in culture

Paul Benoît did so well in Longeuil that he decided, on November 20, 1682 to exchange his property of Montreal, on which he had lived for over 13 years, and its 20 arpents of land, with his neighbor at Longeuil, François Bleau, a baker.. In addition, Bleau gave Benoit 90 livres and erased a 10 work-days debt that Paul owed him. Paul gave up the trade of carpenter. He had built, close to Notre-Dame - of Bonsecours, a “portion of bastiment” for the account of Jean Petit, sior of Boismorel. The owner was not content with this work. Paul and Jean, on October 11, 1683, referred to some qualified estimators to settle their disagreement by amicable agreement.

Children Gobinet-Benoit

Elisabeth Gobinet and Paul Benoît had eleven children in the space of twenty years. All of the children have their baptismal certificates in Ville-Marie. However the last three were born Longeuil. All reached adulthood, a record at the time. Their names, by order of birth, are:: Elisabeth; Laurent; Etienne; twins BARBE and Marie-Anne; Helene; Marguerite; Genevieve; Jacques; Francois; Yves.

Elisabeth, BARBE, Marie-Anne, Helene and Marguerite respectively married François Bleau, THOMAS HÉBERT, and François Bory, Jean Bourdon and Jean Basset, Guillaume Goyau, Jean Tournois and cumulated 35 children. Marguerite alone had twelve of them. Genevieve, the wife of Pierre Hay main sculptor; died without posterity after 10 months of marriage only. Marie-Anne marries in second weddings of Jean Basset, was killed by Iroquois in 1697

Paul's son, Jacques Benoit, disappeared from records after March 7, 1669; Yves after November 24, 1710. On June 23, 1706, Yves had committed himself to serving his mother for one year for wages of 150 pounds. As for Laurent, Etienne and François they took for wife Marie-Francoise Tétreau, Jeanne Campeau, Angélique Chagnon. They were the only ones to transmit the patronym Benoit-Livernois, with their 31 children.

During their youth, Laurent, Etienne, and Francois were couriers du bois. Laurent was an employee of Charles Aubert, sior of Lachenaie. He started from Michilimakinac on August 10, 1683, and on December 10, settled along the river Tématiki (Kankakee) where he wintered. In March, he was stripped of Fur skins by Amerindians. Etienne was working in the west. The men found the fur trade extremely profitable. On November 17, 1682, Laurent was able to lend 300 pounds to his father.

End of a reign

On January 1, 1686, Paul Benoît; died. The parish of Longeuil was in mourning. Paul Benoit was buried on Thursday, January 3, 1686 at Boucherville, Quebec, Canada.in the presence of Laurent, his oldest son; Lord Charles Lemoyne; and Jean-Louis Jadon, Lord of St-Circus, captain in the army. The priest Pierre de Caumont conducted the funeral ceremony. Paul was 66 years of age, according to the register.

Elisabeth Gobinet, a woman of strength and courage, continued to oversee the family farm. On January 20, 1692, François Bleau, her son-in-law, a baker in Ville-Marie, received an advance of 200 pounds on an inheritance. That same day, Elisabeth acknowledged that she owed 100 pounds to her son Laurent from the succession of her husband. On June 25, 1714, she rented her farm to SurprisingMarin, husband ofMarguerite Cartier.

She had done everything possible to make ends meet. That June 25, 1714, she was found herself in desperate straights. She convened her family before Marin Taillandier, notary of Longueuil. With frankness, she informed them of her financial situation and asked them to help her to go through her last days in dignity, explaining that it would require 300 pounds per annum to meet her expenses. The plan had the approval of of her children and grandchildren.

On April 3, 1715, at St-Antoine de Longueuil, Elisabeth returned her noble soul to God, at 76 years of age. Récollet Nicolas Bernardin spoke in praise of Elisabeth in front of the endeuillée parish. The reign of the first Benoit-Gobinet generation had ended.

Photographer

It is fortunate for Canada and the family of Paul and Elisabeth Benoit that one of their descendants went into a trade that was to help keep their memory alive. In Quebec in 1864, Isaïe Benoit de Livernois, husband of Elect Lemieux, opened a photographic studio. Memories of four generations of Benoit de Livernois were recorded by Isaïe Benoit de Livernois. He preserved a very large number of items, including negatives on glass, tests on paper albumenized with let us tons hot of copper with gold chloride, all preserved at the public records of Quebec and the public records of Canada, more than 150,000 stereotypes. The files of the basilica Co.-Anne-of-Bowsprit also have a few hundred items.”

From the internet regarding Barbe Marie Benoit dit Livernois, mother of Marie Barbe Hebert dit LaRose:

BARBE BENOIT, daughter of PAUL BENOIT/BENOIST, a carpenter, and his wife, ISABELLE GABINET

Twin sister to Marie-Anne, was baptised at Notre-Dame de Montreal 9 May 1665. These twins are the second ever to be born to New France settlers. Her name appears during confirmations on May 25, 1676; the twins are then 11 years old.

Her first marriage is to Thomas Hebert dit Larose, 7 February 1679 at Ste-Famille-de-Boucherville. He was the son of Thomas Hebert and Elizabeth l'Homme de St-Omer, Bayeux, Normandie. The ceremony is celebrated by J G Debrullion priest, and present are Paul Benoit, Elisabeth Gobinet, Pierre Duchesne dit St-Onge, Etienne Trudeau, and Francois Leber.

Census 1681, the couple live in Laprairie, he being 30 and she 16 years old. The census taker calls him Leber instead of Hebert, no children for the moment. There were eventually 7 births to this couple. Her first husband; died, event and date unknown.

She remarried Francois Bory de Grandmaison 7 March 1699, son of Laurent Bory de Grandmaison and Marguerite Merie d'Aupre. Two more children will be born to this union, she; died before 1704 and a total of 9 births are known to Barbe.

Francois Bory remarried a 3rd time Marie-Anne Diel October 27, 1704 at Laprairie and had one more daughter who; died as an infant.

Francois Bory was killed in 1711, while involved in an "en filibust," or attack against the English. A small trunk was returned to Laprairie and an assembly of parents was held 34 November to declare tutors for his children.

Barbe was the 4th child born to Paul and Elizabeth Gobinet. She preceded her twin sister Marie-Anne (5th) in birth.

“Martin Benoist dit LaBrière left La Rochelle, France, for Acadie in the Spring of 1671 aboard l’Oranger. He was 28 yrs old. Marie Chaussegros, who was 15 at the time, was also aboard ll’Oranger. Marie was from Rochefort, a city not far from La Rochelle. She and Martin Benoist married, either at La Rochelle just before boarding the ship, or shortly after their arrival in Port-Royal, Acadie. Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros, along with their family, spent their first 30 years in Acadie in the vicinity of Port-Royal. Their ten children were born there. In the period between 1690 and 1700 it is known that Martin lived just inland from Port-Royal on the north bank of the Rivière-des-Dauphins (Annapolis River). Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros had five girls and five boys. Jacqueline, the first daughter, married Michel de Forest in 1686 at the age of 13 Michel’s great uncle, Jesse De Forest was the founder of New York. Michel was

widowed from Marie Hébert and 47 years old when he married Jacqueline. They had one child, a girl, Marguerite, born 1687, who married Étienne Comeau in 1701. Michel de Forest; died in 1690 and Jacqueline married a second time to Guillaume Trahan the same year. They had eight children, six boys and two girls. Guillaume; died in 1755 before the Deportation. However, Marguerite was one of its victims and; died in the autumn of 1755 either shortly before or shortly after her arrival in Virginia. Virginia refused to accept the Acadians, and they were sent to Liverpool, England, and held prisoners. Many of the children of Guillaume and Marguerite ended up in Liverpool, where at least three of them; died. The others eventually made it back to France after their release at the end of the Seven Years War (known as the French and Indian War). Marie, the second daughter of Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros; died on June 11, 1714, at the age of 35. She was single and living with her parents at the time of her death. Catherine, the third daughter of Martin and Marie, married François LePrince in 1712. Catherine was among those deported by the English and; died in France in 1760. At least four of her seven children were also deported. One son, Claude Prince, along with his wife, Madeleine Doiron, and their entire family; died at sea during the deportation. The others who were deported were in France in the late 1760's. The fourth daughter, Jeanne, married Pierre LeJeune in 1712. This family moved to Ile St-Jean (Prince Edward Island). Four of their ten children, Anne, Brigitte, Eloi, and Augustin; died during the Deportation. Another, Joseph, along with his wife Anne-Théotiste Brasseur and their family, found refuge in Québec. Another, Jean; died in France in 1758 at the age of 34. Françoise, the fifth daughter, married Alexandre Thibodeau around 1715. He; died before the deportation but Françoise was deported to Maryland. Two of their three daughters; died before the Deportation. However, Anne who married Jean Doiron in 1752 was deported to France.

The five sons of Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros and their descendants were also scattered by the Deportation. Their first son Pierre the elder probably; died before the Deportation. His children who survived to 1755 and most of his grandchildren were victims of the British. His daughter, Marguerite; died during the Deportation en route to France. His grandchildren from his son Martin, were perhaps the most scattered. One grandson, René, was in Maryland in 1763. One grandson of the original Martin Benoist, Pierre-Olivier, the son of Martin; died in Louisiana in 1787. One of Pierre-Olivier's daughters, born 1760 in Maryland, married in a second marriage to the nephew of the celebrated Daniel Boone, also named Daniel Boone. Others of Pierre-Olivier's children settled in the St. Martinville and Petite Anse regions of South Louisiana. Pierre, another of Pierre the elder (l'ainé), had three granddaughters, the daughters of his son, Jean-Baptiste, who also settled and married in Louisiana. These grand-daughters, Rosalie married 1770 Louis-Romain de la Fosse, married 1796 Joseph Campeau; Marie-Anne married 1774 Michel Janis; Marguerite married abt 1774 Louis Broussard. All settled in the Opelousas region. The second son of Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros, Clément married 1704 Anne Babin, widow of Abraham Doiron. He; died before the Deportation. Clément's son Claude married 1706 to Marie Comeau and was deported with his family to Massachusetts, where his children were taken and placed in the home of a Mr. Duncan Campbell. When Claude and his wife moved near the Campbells to be near their children, Campbell promptly scattered the children to other families in Massachusetts. After reaching adulthood, most of Claude's children married and eventually were able to leave Massachusetts for refuge in Québec. Another of Clément's children, Catherine, was deported to Maryland where she and her husband; died. At least one child of Clément's son, Alexis married Helene Comeau, made it to Louisiana from Massachusetts. Anne Benoit married Amand Broussard, son of the Acadian patriot, Joseph dit

Beausoleil Broussard, on May 24, 1775, at St. Martinville.

< P> Martin and Marie's third son, Jean married 1704 to Marie-Anne Brault, married 1731 to Marie Amirault - he had 14 children. They and their children were also scattered during the Deportation. At least one, Jean, was dead before the Deportation, but his widow; died at sea during the Deportation. Another son, Olivier married Marie-Anne Part, and his entire family; died at sea. Three children, Françoise, Madeleine and Anne-Marie went to France. One daughter, Catherine-Marie; died in Martinique. Another of Jean's sons Claude, married 1737 Anne Comeau, had his children and grandchildren scattered to France, England, the Faulkland Island, Newfoundland and Louisiana. The son of Claude who went to Louisiana, Étienne, settled with his family first at St. Jacques de Cabahannocer (St. James Parish). Most of his children resettled in the St. Martinville area. Some of Claude's grandchildren ended up in Guadeloupe. The fourth son of Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros, Pierre le cadet (the younger) married 1703 to Elisabeth LeJuge. They had 12 children. One child, Paul and his entire family, save for one daughter; died at sea during the Deportation from Ile St-Jean. Many of his grandchildren escaped the Deportation and resettled in Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, and Prince Edward Island. One of his sons, Charles, was deported to France, where he; died, but most of his children left France for Louisiana in 1785. These Benoits mostly settled the Lafourche region: Marie, married 1757 Rene Rasicot, married 1766 Joseph Hébert and; died 1806 in Louisiana; Françoise married 1758 Honoré Caret in Lafourche; Jean-Charles married 1770 Anne-Marie Haché and; died 1787 in Louisiana. Claude Benoit was the ninth child of Pierre le cadet. One of his sons, Grégoire married 1770 Marie-Rose Caret and was deported to France and left for Louisiana in 1785 aboard the St-Rémi. His children mostly settled at Plattenville in Assumption Parish. Others from this Benoit line were deported to Massachusetts. Claude, the fifth son of Martin Benoist and Marie Chaussegros, had 11 children. Seven were deported to Massachusetts, three found refuge in Québec, and one escaped the Deportation in present day New Brunswick. Most of those deported to Massachusetts who survived into the 1760s made their way either to New Brunswick or Québec with their families and are the ancestors of most of the Benoits living today in these regions.

NOTE: The website for the Acadian Memorial doesn't list the surname “Latier”, but it lists both “Benoit” and “Trahan”. Whether “Latier” (or “Ledet”) is listed, one would have to see the wall to find out.

It may be that Louis Latier was not Acadian. He was Marie-Ann Trahan's second husband.

Louis Latier and Marie Ann Trahan Benoit were married around 1762 in Maryland, after her husband, Jean Baptiste Benoit died about 1761.

Article from the internet about the Trahan family: The history of the Trahan family is tied to silk weaving in France. The etymology of the name "the one who pulled the silk" used to leave me perplexed, a name known in the Touraine region in the 16th and 17th century. Our research led us to find a bourgeois in Tours and another in Joue-les-Tours. Intriguing, because I had thought Touraine was not a region known for silk production—and later found it was after all, from the days that the king Louis XI (1423-1483) introduced the silk worm and the mulberry tree to feed them around his city of Tours. Just as he brought the silk worms, this king could also have brought the Trahans, the workers of silk. Silk weaving was done in Tours long before it was introduced to Lyon in 1536, although Lyon became a silk center. In studying the history of the Languedoc , I discovered the existence of the "Trahandiers" of the Cevennes mountains (see Le Roy-Ladurie: Paysans du Languedoc). It was in Anduze (Gard) that Raymond de Caussargues pulled the first silk thread in 1296 He was the first bona fide "trahandier", silk puller, reeler of cocoons. In the XIV century, the corporation of the trahandiers was flourishing in Anduze, and their wares were selling in markets in Avignon and Beaucaire (Gard). The name "trahandier" strangely was not Languedocian, but French, and came from the vulgar Latin "trahandere". In Provençal, we have the name "magnanier", the silk worm breeder, and "magnan", the silk worm itself. Trahan is supposed to have the same significance as Magnan, both names attached to silk worm breeding. But by what roundabout route would trahandier or trahan cevenol have arrived at the Touraine area? Perhaps we could find the answer by going to Beaucaire at the time of Louis XI.

Beaucaire, situated on the Rhone River, had the largest trade fair of all of France, and was well attended not only by French merchants, but also Flemish, German, Catalan, and Spanish. Some also came from Balearic Islands, Genoa, Naples, and the Piedmont. Beaucaire was a royal city under Louis XI, whereas neighbouring Avignon was a papal city. These cities both sold the

products of the trahandiers from nearby Cevennes. From those noble corporations, this silk was henceforth woven in France. This silk must have pleased the king Louis XI, for he introduced the practice of silk worm breeding in his city of Tours. When we look at today's patronyms in the provinces of France, we see that some of them are still used in the village, or surrounding area, of the same name. The residence of these families is therefore the same as it was at the beginning of the civil registration. Today, the descendants of Guillaume Trahan live on both sides of the Atlantic due to the Acadian deportation of 1755. We can find them in Canada, USA, Belle-Ile-en-mer, and western France. The family settled in the Grande Prairie area of the Opelousas District north of present-day Washington, Louisiana before moving up to the Avoyelles prairie by the mid-1790s. Their daughter married into the Labaterie family. Some of Louis's sons moved back into St. Landry Parish in the early 1800s.

MARIE ANNE TRAHAN was the daughter of ETIENNE TRAHAN and MARIE-FRANCOISE ROY.

She married JEAN-BAPTISTE BENOIT, son of PIERRE BENOIT and ANNE-MARIE GAUDET on May 24, 1751. They had three children, MARGUERITE, Anne and Rose.

The Trahan family was exiled to Maryland, where JEAN-BAPTISTE BENOIT died about 1761; MARIE-ANNE married a second time in Maryland about 1762 to Louis Latier/Ledet.

On a list of Acadians at Portabaco, Maryland dated 7 July 1763 is:

Louis Latier, ANNE (TRAHAN) LATIER his wife, Antoine Latier, Anne Benoist, orphan, Rose Benoist, orphan, MARGUERITE BENOIST, orphan.

moreover my grandson named André Plauché legitimate son of my late son André Plauché deceased at Pointe Coupée, which said [...] grandson André Plauché aged about nineteen years has left from here for [the North] about eight years ago without having any news from him or of his existence, and moreover five children of my late daughter Louise Marguerite Plauché deceased in this city wife of Sir François Chessé residing in this city. I declare having passed on the occasion of my marriage [with] the above said my deceased husband Etienne Plauché my marriage contract at [... ..] of the late Sir Gaire notary in this city, which contract I approve and to which I refer. I declare that the succession of the said late Etienne Plauché, my husband, is not yet liquidated nor even the inventories done nor begun. Declaring moreover that my above mentioned husband gave his last will {in the hands} of the late Sir Etienne de Quiñones, notary in this city when still living, to which last will, already homologated by the Court of [...] of this parish, I refer, having asked Mr. Pierre Morel [...] the business of the succession, in his quality of [...] of said succession. I declare that my three above said married daughters, i.e. Dame Jean Jacques Chessé, Dame Jean Vital Michel, and Dame {François} Chessé this latter deceased, have each received on the occasion of their wedding the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, by way [...] according to their marriage contract to which I refer. I give and bequeathe in the best form of law, by way of an advantage and outside their share of inheritance to each of my said four daughters, the sum of three hundred dollars which will be accounted by the executor of my will in money [...] which gives in total twelve hundred dollars, i.e. Marie Magdelaine Plauché wife of said Sir Jean Jacques Chessé, Marguerite Mélanie Plauché wife of said Sir Jean Vital Michel, Marie Victoire Plauché [unmarried] girl, and to the children and representatives [...] said late Louise Marguerite Plauché deceased wife of Sir François Chessé. I designate as executor of my will and [holder] of my belongings the above said Sir Jean Jacques Chessé my son-in-law, authorizing him to act in all matters related to my succession without any intervention of the Law insofar as possible. I institute as unique and universal inheritors and in equal parts, after deducting the bequest, my six above said living children, and the representatives of the deceased other two. I annul and revoke any and all testaments and codicils that I may have done before the present one which I decide as containing my last will." So has this testament been dictated by said Dame testator to said notary who wrote it with his own hand as it was dictated to him [... ..] and without diverting to other acts and in the presence of the undersigned witnesses, and the notary having read this testament in the same presence to said Dame testator, the latter declared to hear and understand it well and perseverate. Done and passed in New Orleans in the above designated house on the seventh day of the month of June of the year one thousand eight hundred eighteen, the forty second of the American Independence in the presence of Messrs. Personal notes from the transcriber: This testament was dictated the day before Marguerite Selam; died. She did not die in her own house but in that of her daughter and Chessé son-in-law. In this will, she favors her daughters, two of whom had married in the Chessé family. The donation that she makes in this document would normally be considered illegal in French law: donations made close to someone's death must be considered as part of the inheritance. The above testament was dictated the day before Marguerite Selam; died. She did not die in her own house but in that of her daughter and Chessé son-in-law. In this will, she favors her daughters, two of whom had married in the Chessé family. NOTE for the Bordelon family: GABRIEL LAURENT BORDELON: The first Bordelon in Louisiana was born Le Havre, France on 25 October 1696 and baptized the next day at the Church of Notre Dame, Le Havre, France.

Laurent, as he was called in Louisiana, was the son of Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon and Magdeleine de Brachon. Jean Baptiste was "contrôleur de vivres de la marine" at the Port of Le Havre. This term "de vivres" refers to supply, subsistence, and commissary functions of the Navy.

By 1711 JEAN BAPTISTE BORDELON was employed at the port of Rochefort, France as "directeur des vivres de la marine" of that port. From letters of the court the 1711 to 1712 in the Archives of the Port of Rochefort, it appears that Bordelon had left his wife at Le Havre.

In 1719 Dame Magdeleine de Richouf, wife of Jean Baptiste Thomas Bordelon, successfully sued her husband for separation of the assets of their community.

LAURENT BORDELON, son of Jean Baptiste Bordelon, was married at Saint Louis Parish, New Orleans, Louisiana on 20 February 1730 to Anne Françoise Roland. In the record of this marriage, Laurent is described as an employee of the company. He names his parents as Jean Baptiste Bordelon and Henriette Rochechouart. It is possible that his father was married for a third time, and Henriette was the step-mother of Laurent.
